**OCCA Guidelines for Basketball Goal Installation and Maintenance**

Basketball goals are regulated by Amendments dated July 7, 2004 in which all outdoor play equipment is regulated.

- I. Types Allowed
  - a. Basketball goals installed after the date of adoption of this guideline or replaced after the adoption date shall be of the clear glass type. Solid goals will no longer be permitted.
- II. Color
  - a. Basketball goals, their frames and supporting poles shall be black *or forest green*. Existing poles in need of maintenance shall be repainted in black *or forest green*, even if this was not the original color.
- III. Installation
  - a. Basketball goals shall be installed on poles designed for such purpose and poles shall be installed per manufacturer's instructions in concrete using generally accepted practices and materials.
- IV. Lighting
  - a. No lighting shall be permitted to be installed on any basketball goal nor shall any permanent exterior lighting be installed intended to light a basketball goal or playing area on any lot.
- V. Times of Use
  - a. In the spirit of good neighbor cooperation, no use of a basketball goal shall cause an annoyance to other Neighbors.
- VI. Maintenance
  - a. All basketball goals regardless of installation date shall be maintained in acceptable condition as determined solely by the Board, or its representatives and designees. Acceptable condition includes but is not limited to being maintained rust free, clean, with surface and markings in good condition. Nets shall be maintained and replaced as necessary.
  - b. The Board may demand repair or ultimately removal of any basketball goal that is not maintained in acceptable condition as determined by the Board, Architectural Chair or General Manager.
- VII. Acceptance of Guidelines:
  - a. By receiving approval for a basketball installation, each property owner acknowledges these guidelines and agrees to abide by them.
